



Space To Serve On Broadband Council

Gov. Ted Strickland has named U.S. Rep. Zack Space, D-Dover, who represents much of Ross County, to serve on the Ohio Broadband Council.

The council's task is to find ways to connect all of Ohio to a broadband infrastructure. Space's selection to the council was based primarily on his experiences with his own Appalachian Ohio Broadband Task Force.

The council will develop a phased implementation of Broadband Ohio, develop a strategic plan for statewide broadband deployment, coordinate all broadband activities that receive state funds and pursue new federal and private-sector investments, establish policies and promote new public and private broadband networking investments and develop a strategic plan to achieve digital inclusion.
